**Measured Mile**

Before you arrive at the Highwayman Inn start venue you may wish, to calibrate any tripmeters in line with the one used to compile the roadbook).

**SIGNING-ON**

This will take place at The Highwayman Inn 08.30 to 10.45.

Please see enclosed maps.

**Please aim to arrive at least 45 Mins before your start time.**

On arrival at The Highwayman Inn please park as per the enclosed plan and as directed by our marshals.

Sign on and collect your road book and rally plate.

Breakfast rolls and a hot drink will be available to all participants.

**VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION**

Vehicles will be identified by registration number and 'Monte Carlo' style rally plates (approx 200 x 100mm), supplied by the organisers and to be affixed (by participants) to the inside of the front windscreen, or to the front bodywork or bumper of the vehicle. These **must** be placed in a visible position.

**New for this Year**

New for this Year you will be provided within your packs high visibility numbers matching your start number. These **MUST** be fixed to your windscreen in a clear and visible position. They are to aid officials around the route in identifying YOU so that we don't miss you at photo points.

### **TIMING**

We ask you to please start from the Highwayman Inn in the entry list order. Thereafter you may leave our refreshment venues in any order you like but at one minute intervals any time after the departure control opens. Controls close 60 mins after the controls open.

We are continuing this year's event with the changes we made last year, by starting the newer cars at the front of the field. This worked well last year by cutting down the number of complaints we got from participants being held up by slower cars.

Please remember to take time to enjoy the venues that we are visiting and the views and scenery that you pass. This is not a race.

At Sheepscombe Village Hall (afternoon Refreshments Break) you will leave at minute intervals in the order in which you arrived there. The Highwayman Inn do not want us back early as the food will not be ready for you.

### **FOLLOW THE ROUTE**

This Year's route is held on Ordnance Survey Landranger 1.50.000 series sheet numbers 162 & 163.

The route is defined by the 'tulip' diagrams in the Road Book issued at signing-on. The times at which the Route Checks will be open have been established as follows:

Opening: 25mph average from the time of the start of the section.

Closing: 20mph average from the time of the last car starting the section.

The event is a Touring Assembly. There is no timing except for the purpose of preventing competitors travelling too fast or too slow.

In the road book you will find a timing schedule with your car number listed with the timings that you are expected to leave the Route Checks during the day. There are no penalties for not complying with this.

### **FUEL**

The route is approximately 105 Miles long so make sure you have enough fuel to complete the route as there are no fuel stations along the route.

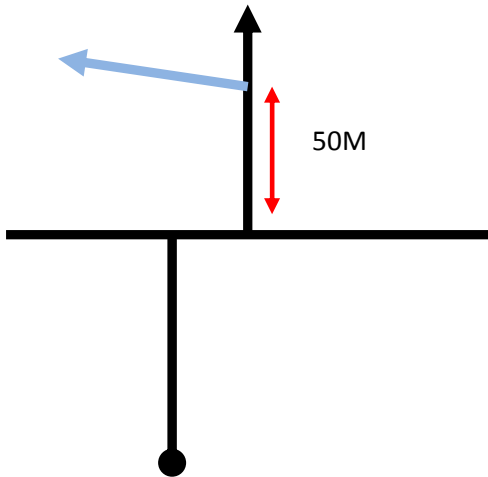


# Highwayman Inn Layout

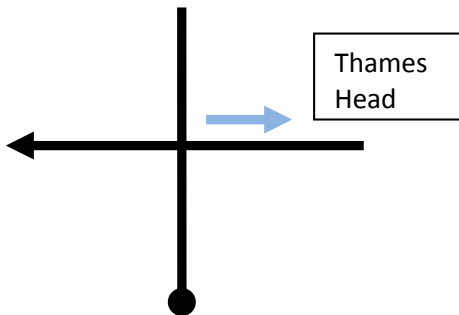
