FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

WELCOME

Today's route has been chosen for its scenic views and fine driving roads although there may be a few customary pot holes! We hope you will enjoy your day out.

Please take a moment to read these final instructions as they will aid your enjoyment of the day and make ours, as organisers, just a little bit easier.

We would like to welcome back Mark & Joanna Knight, regular participants on the Corinium Run who will be adding some enhancements to our event with their support from Tony Williams Bodyshop & Revive "Auto Apothecary".

Measured Mile

Before you arrive at the start venue you may wish, to calibrate any tripmeters in line with the one used to compile the road book.

Please see enclosed map.

PRE START PROCEDURE

Signing on MUST be completed before you arrive at the Start via the online entry system. This can be accessed from your entry acceptance email.

Instructions for this process are listed later in these final instructions

The Highwayman Inn will open for us at 08.00

Please see enclosed map.

Please aim to arrive at least 45 Mins before your start time.

On arrival at The Start please park as directed by our marshals.

Competitor packs containing everything you need to participate on the Corinium Run will be issued at documentation, inside the Highwayman Inn.

Breakfast rolls and a hot drink will be available to all participants in the restaurant.

VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION

Vehicles will be identified by registration number and 'Monte Carlo' style rally plates (approx. 200 x 100mm), supplied by the organisers and to be affixed (by participants) to the inside of the front windscreen, or to the front bodywork or bumper of the vehicle. These **must** be placed in a visible position.

TIMING

We ask you to please start from the Highwayman Inn in the entry list order. Thereafter you may leave our refreshment venues in any order you like but at one minute intervals any time after the departure control opens. Controls close 70 mins after the controls open.

We are reverting back to our old tried and testing format of starting the older cars first, this is in keeping of our values as a classic car scenic tour.

At Chedworth Village Hall 2 (afternoon Refreshments Break) please leave at one minute intervals from 14.41pm. The Highwayman Inn do not want us back early as the food will not be ready for you.

FOLLOW THE ROUTE

This Year's route is held entirely on Ordnance Survey Landranger 1.50.000 series sheet number 163.

The route is defined by the 'tulip' diagrams in the Road Book issued at documentation. The times at which the Route Checks will be open have been established as follows:

Opening: 25mph average from the time of the start of the section.

Closing: 20mph average from the time of the last car starting the section.

The event is a Touring Assembly. There is no timing except for the purpose of preventing competitors travelling too fast or too slow.

In the road book you will find a timing schedule with your car number listed with the times that you are expected to leave the Route Checks during the day. There are no penalties for not complying with this.

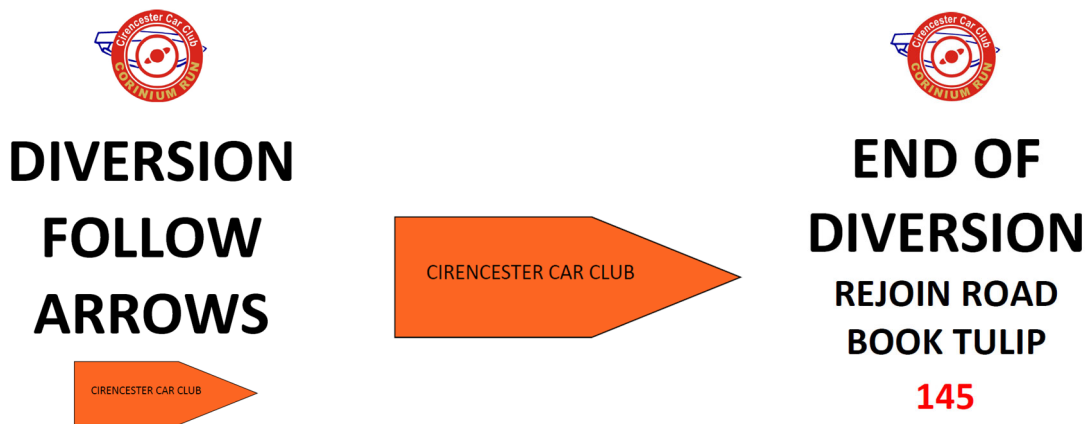

CONDITION OF THE PUBLIC HIGHWAYS

Please be aware that the roads in Gloucestershire are in very poor condition, I know we say each year beware of potholes, but this year is by far worse than ever before, we have reported the worst holes to Gloucestershire Highways and some have been repaired and some sections completely resurfaced, however there are many more that have gone unrepaired, Our course opening cars are equipped with “Beware Pot Holes” signs to try and identify the worst ones, this will complement those identified in the road book, but it will be impossible to sign them all. Please drive accordingly!

Road Closure Diversions.

Last year we were plagued by numerous “On the Day” road works which caused some issues. This year we have two course opening cars running in advance of Car 1 to try sign any diversions. If there are any you will come across Sign 1 placed at the start of a Road Closure, then follow the Cirencester Car Club Orange arrows until at the end of the diversion you will find Sign 2 with a rejoin tulip number.



FUEL

The route is approximately 123 Miles long so make sure you have enough fuel to complete the route, there is one fuel station on the route in section one, tulip 104 after 2 miles.

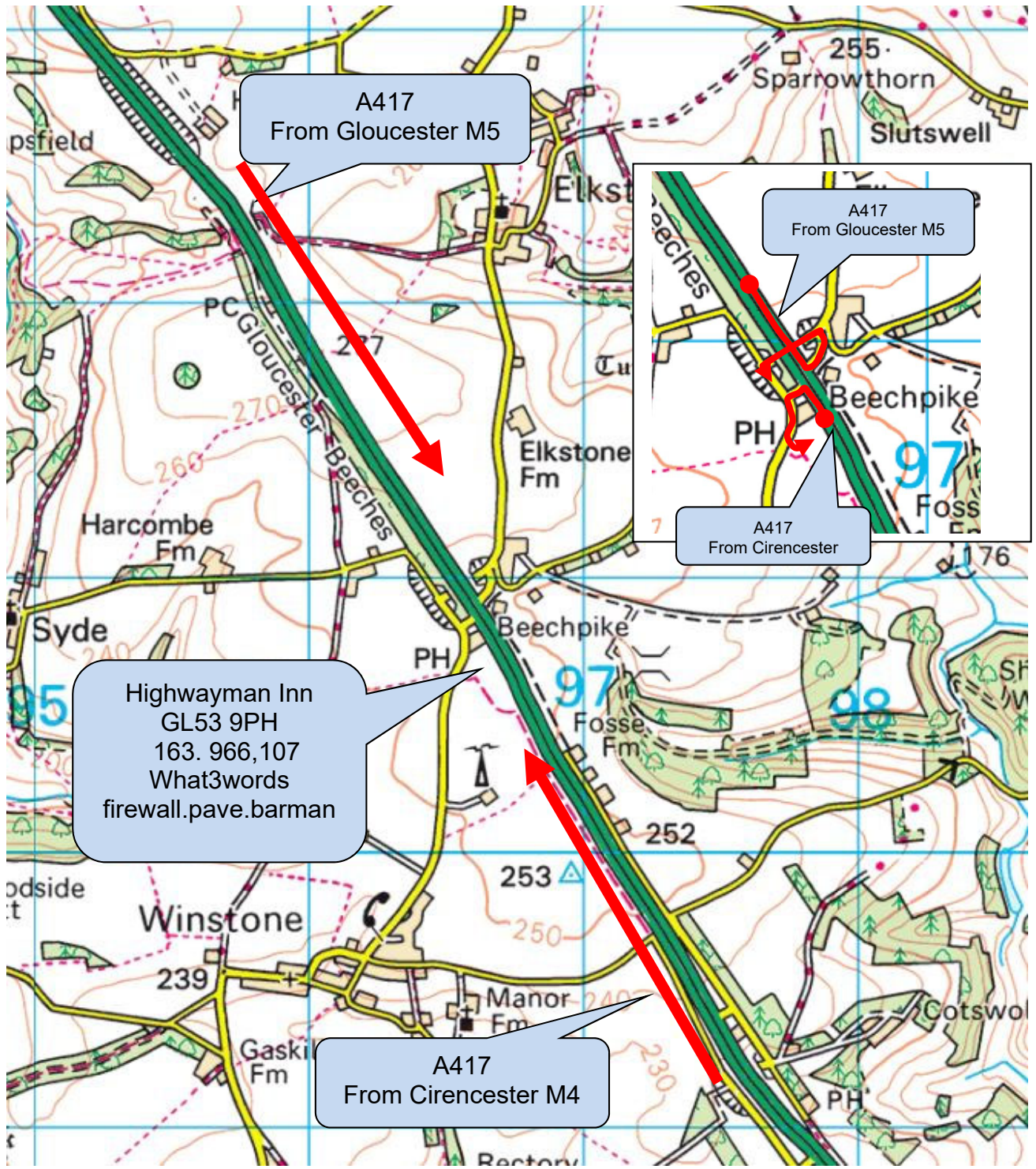

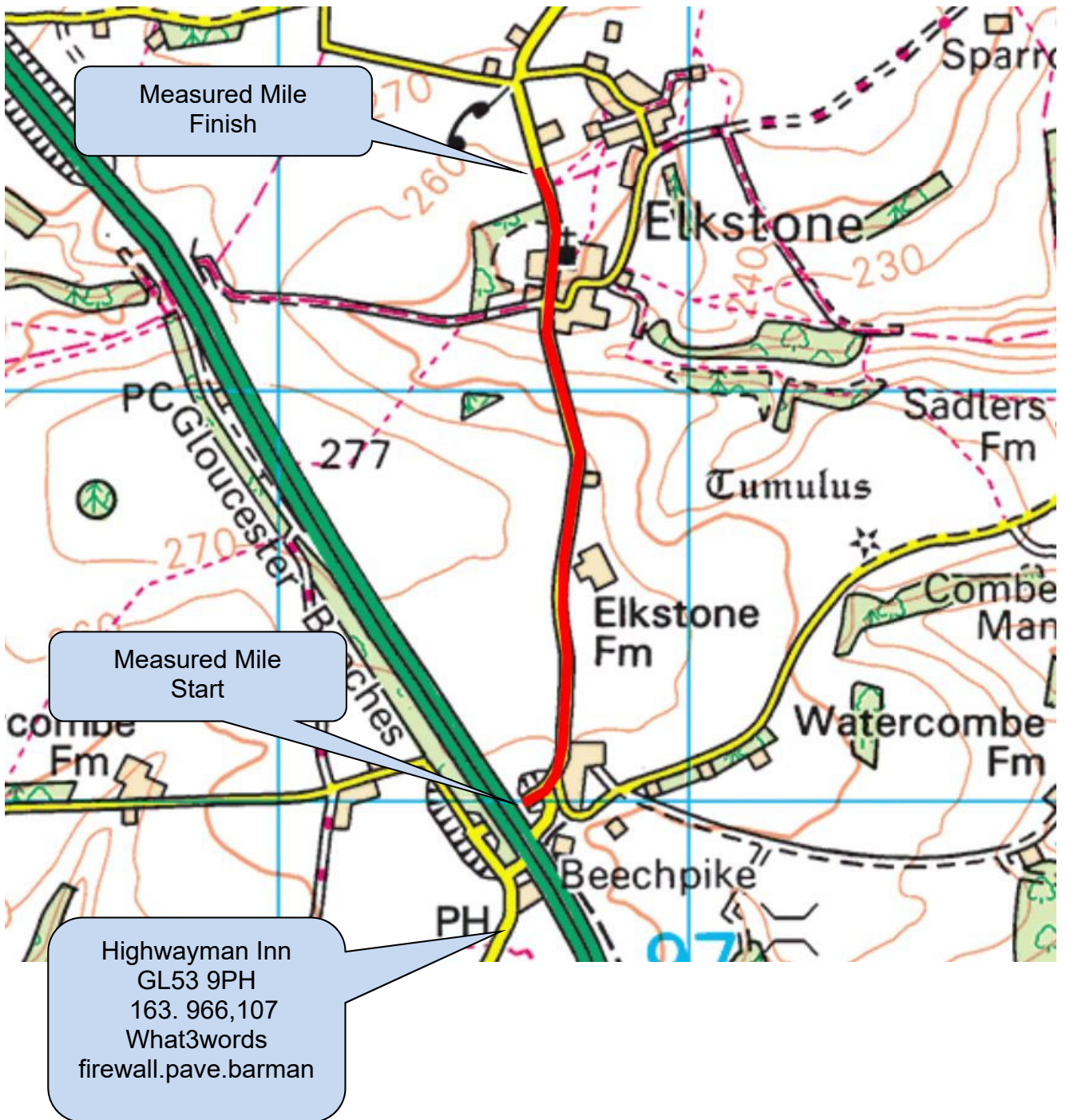
